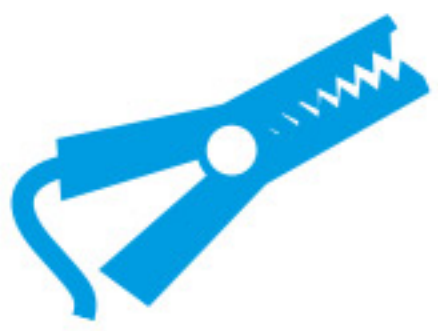

Jumper cables



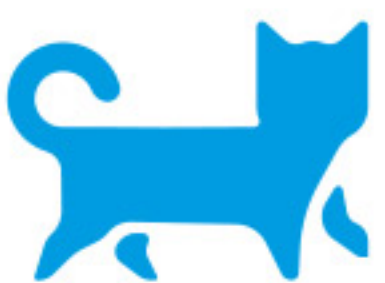
Shovel

Tool kit

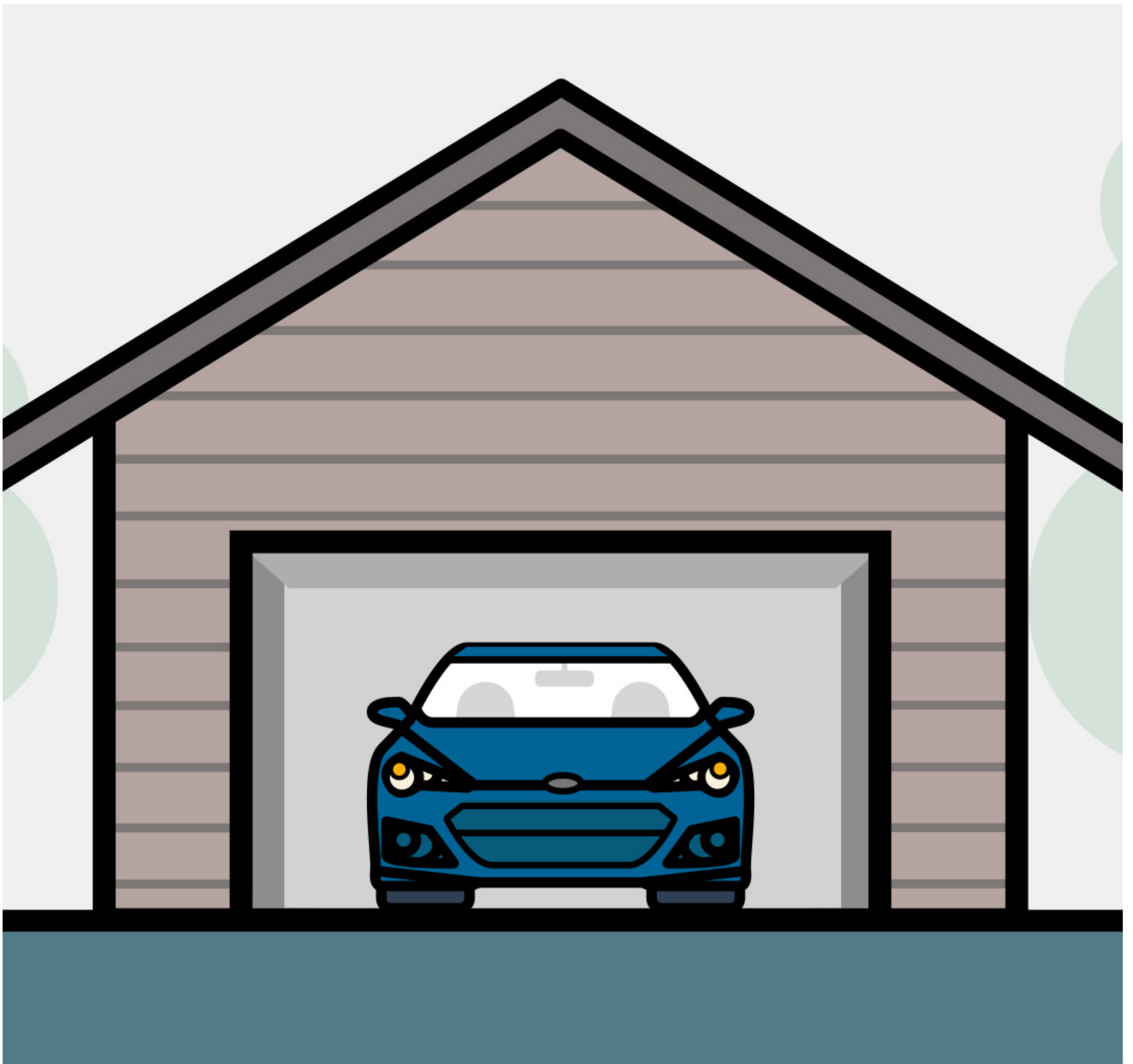
How to Check Your Oil

Check 1x/month.

Check Your Oil

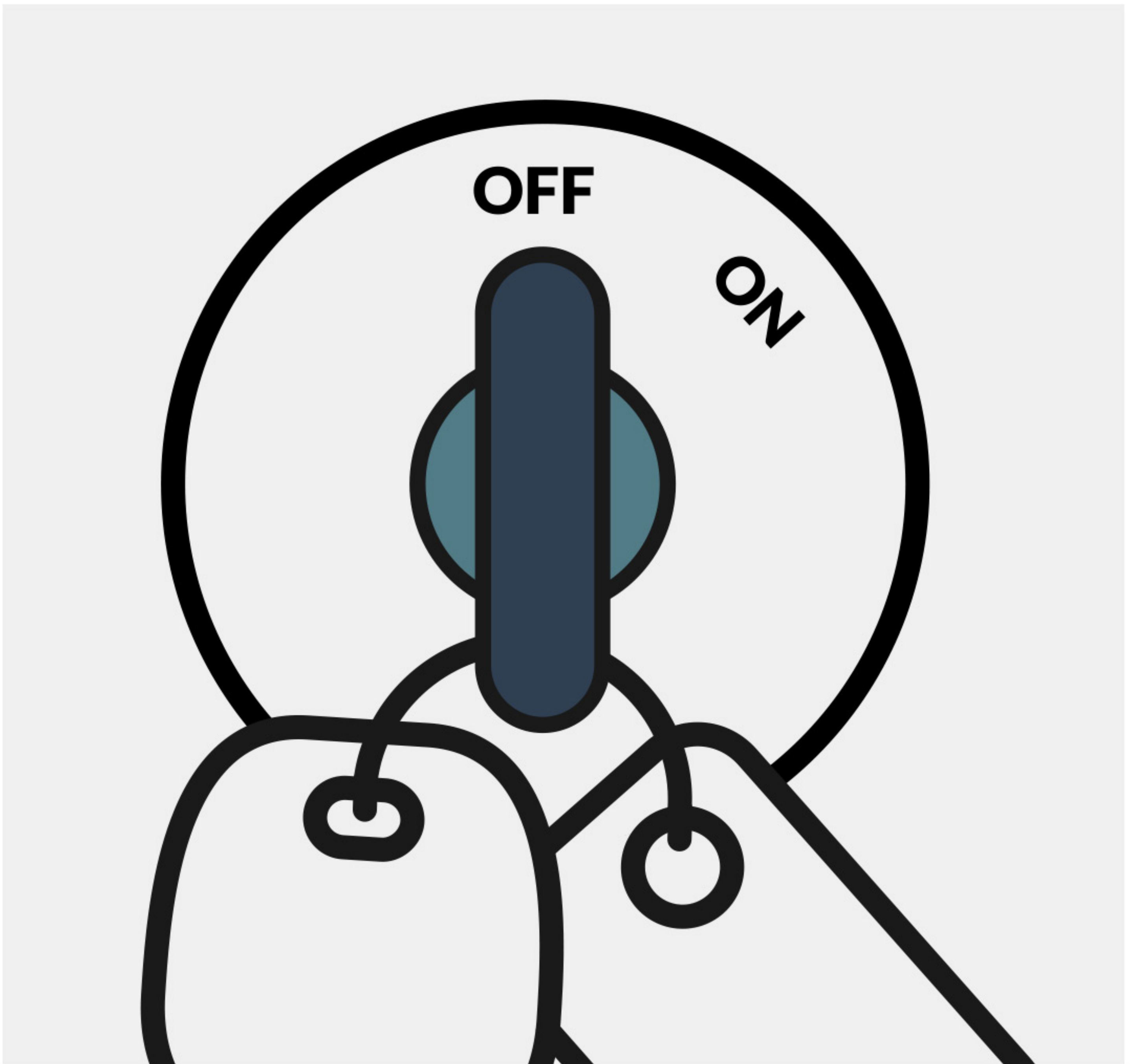
- 1 Park your car on a flat surface.

Check Your Oil

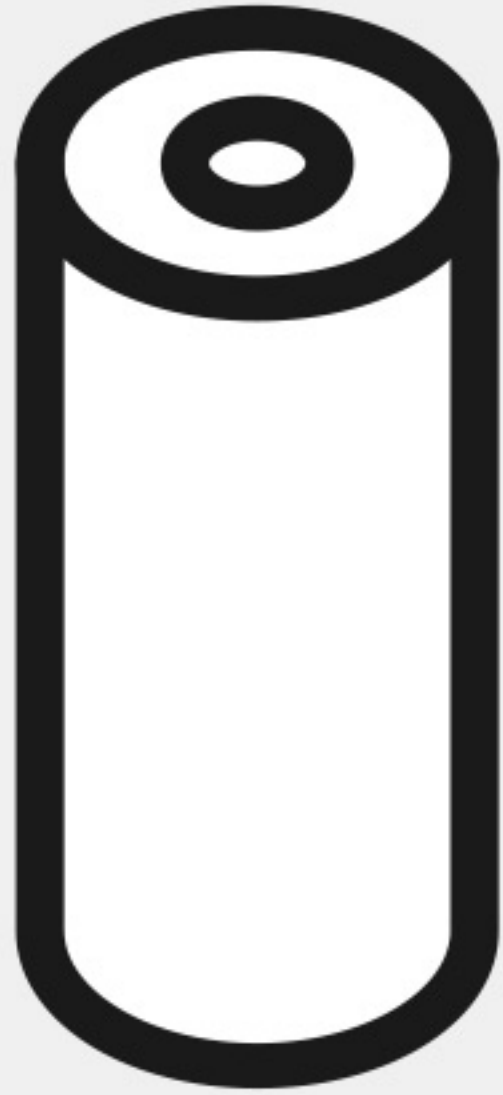
- 2 Turn off engine.
Let sit for 10 minutes.

3 Gather supplies.

Funnel



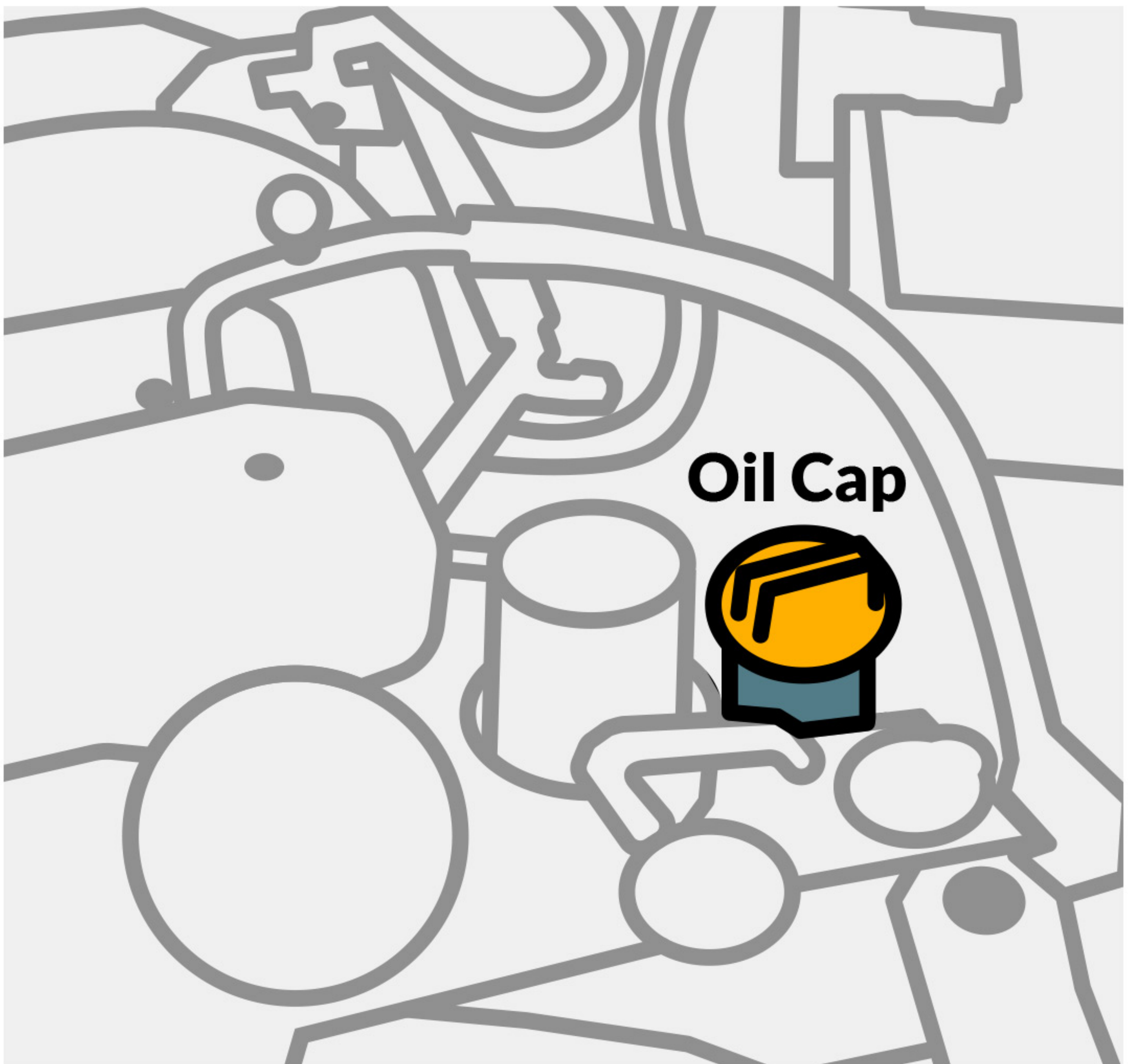
**Latex

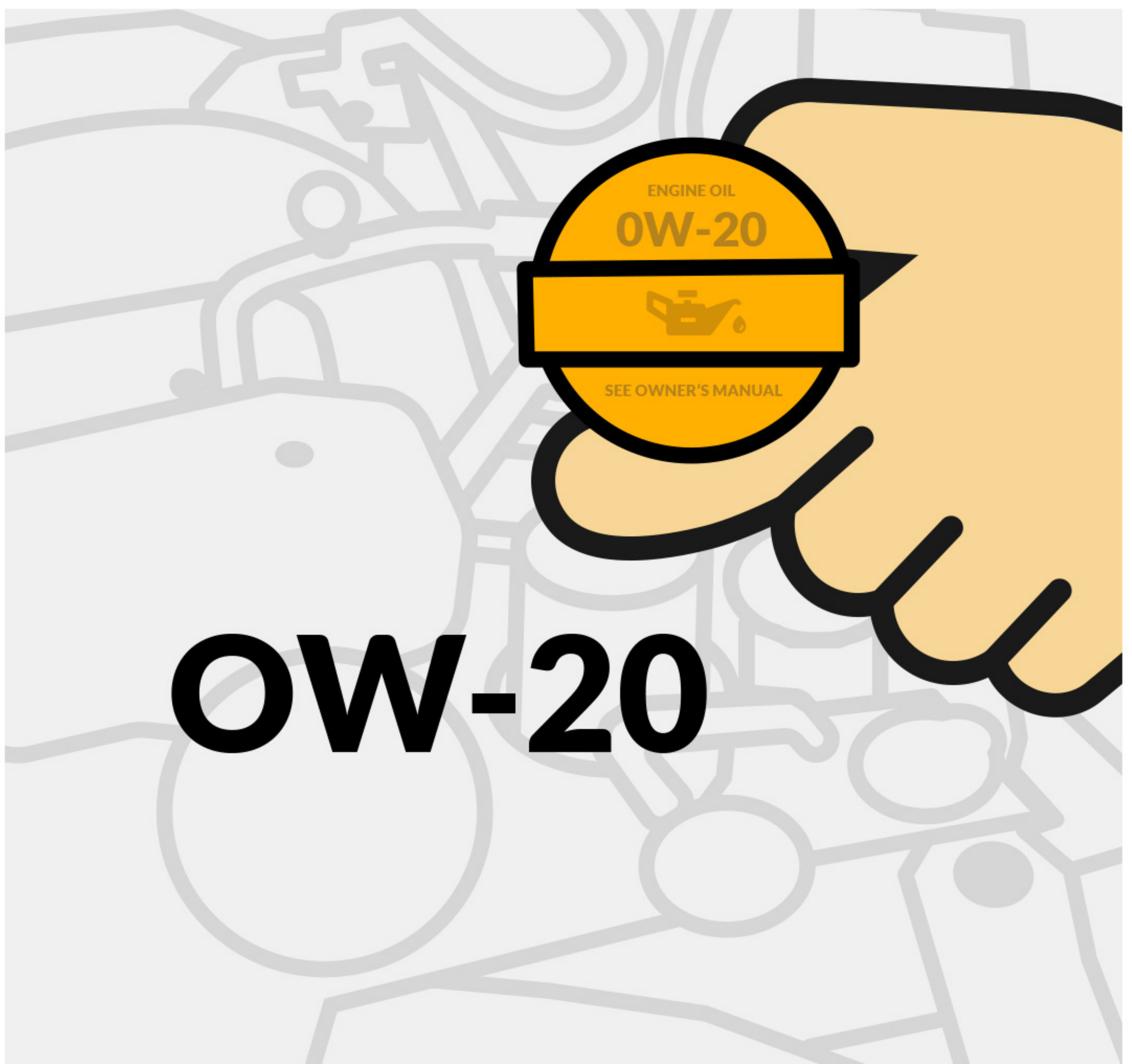
Check Your Oil

- 4 Find the oil cap.
(Look for  symbol.)



HOW TO Check Your Oil

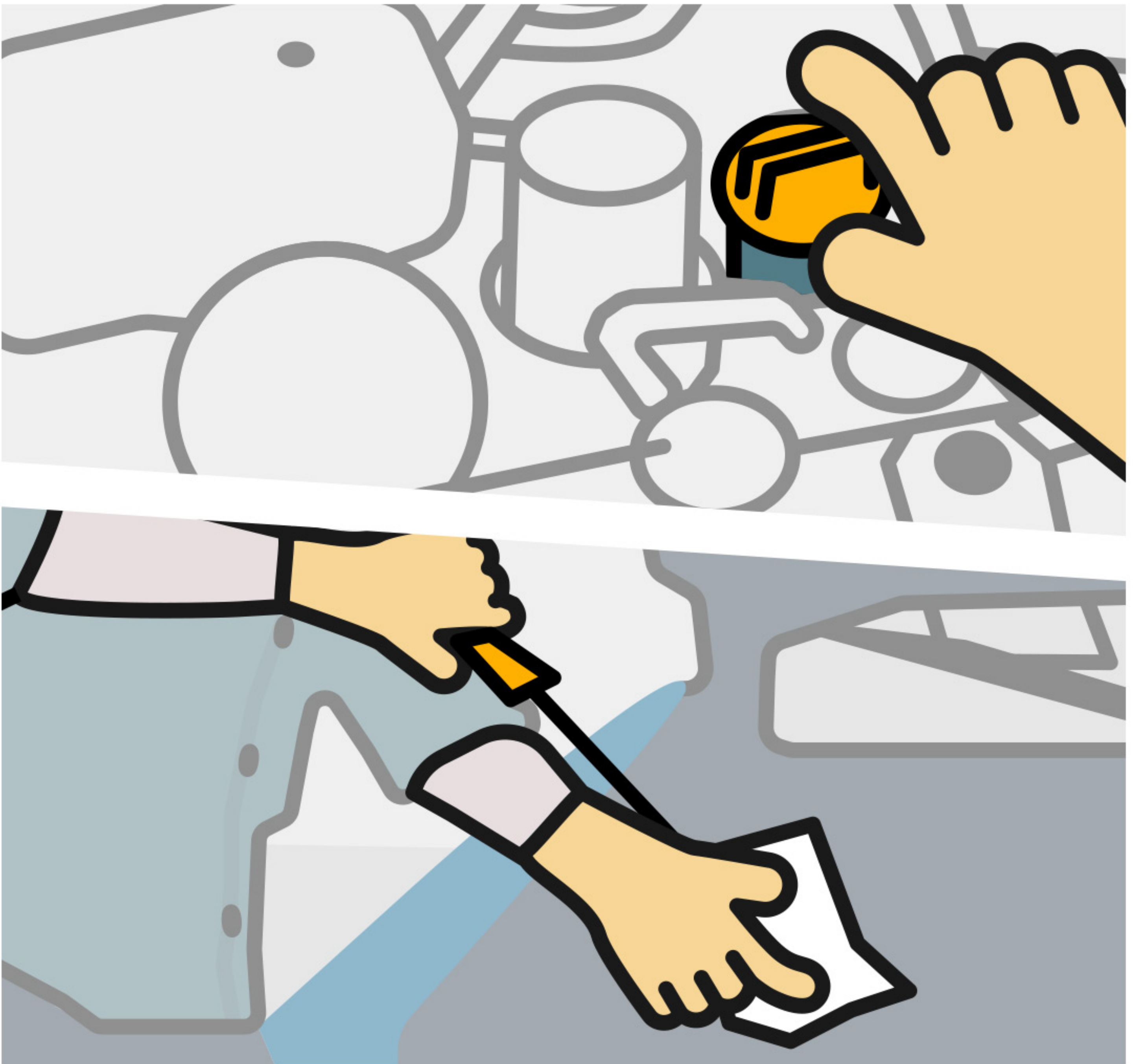
- 5 The cap will show you the oil weight needed.

Check Your Oil

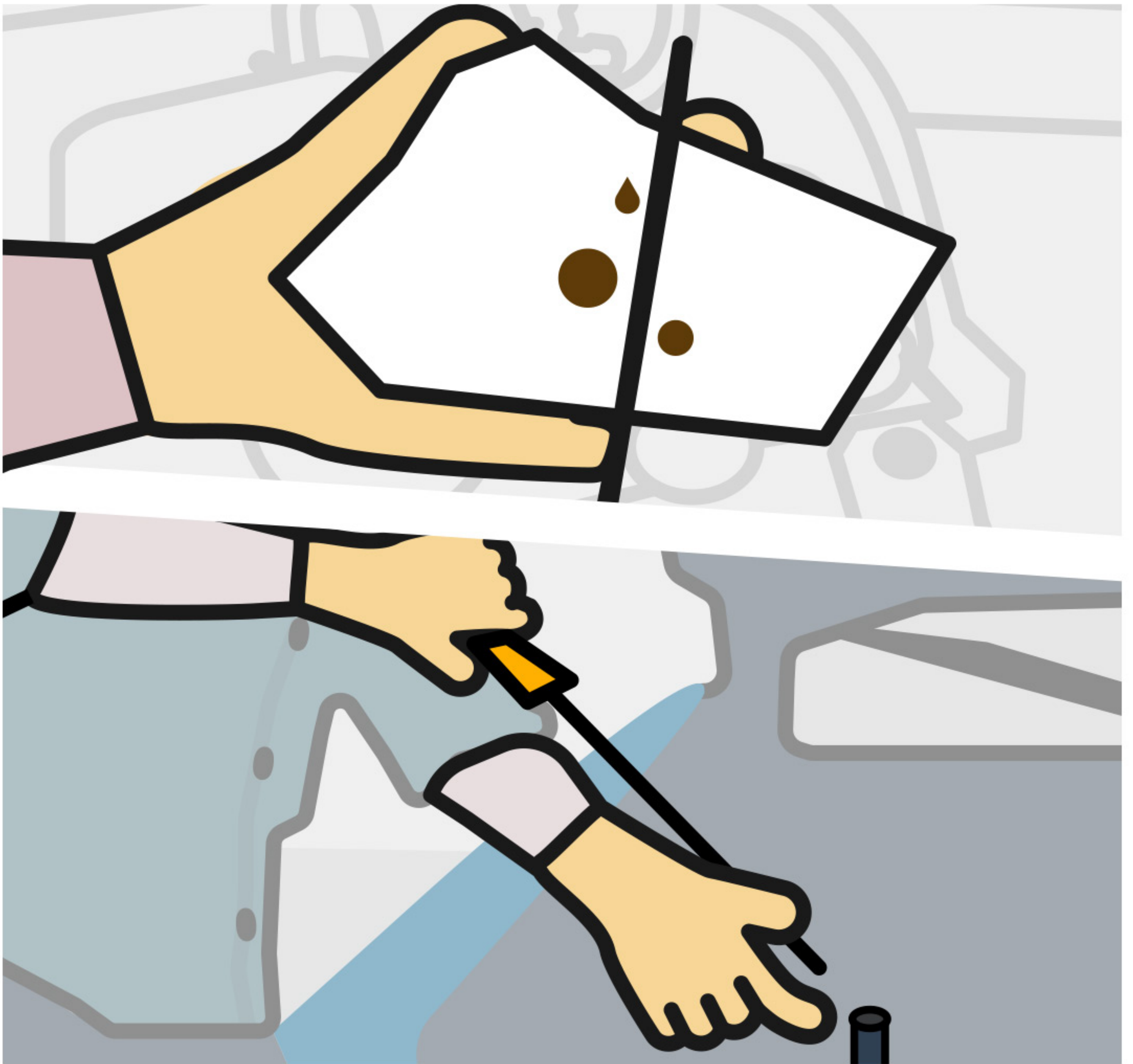
- 6 Unscrew the cap.
Withdraw the dipstick.

Check Your Oil

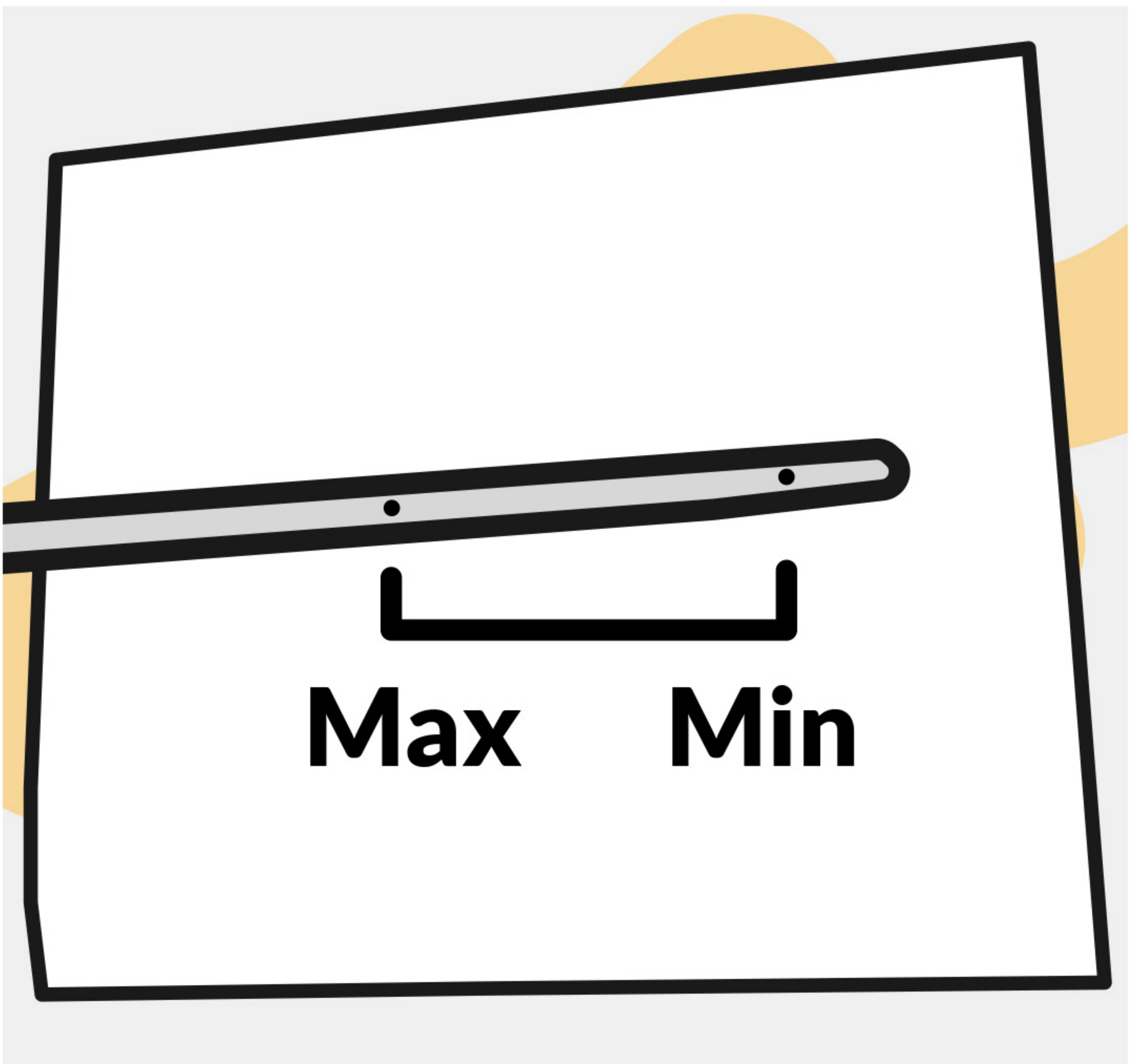
- 7 Clean with paper towel.
Reinsert dipstick.

Check Your Oil

- 8 Remove dipstick to check oil level. Fill as needed.



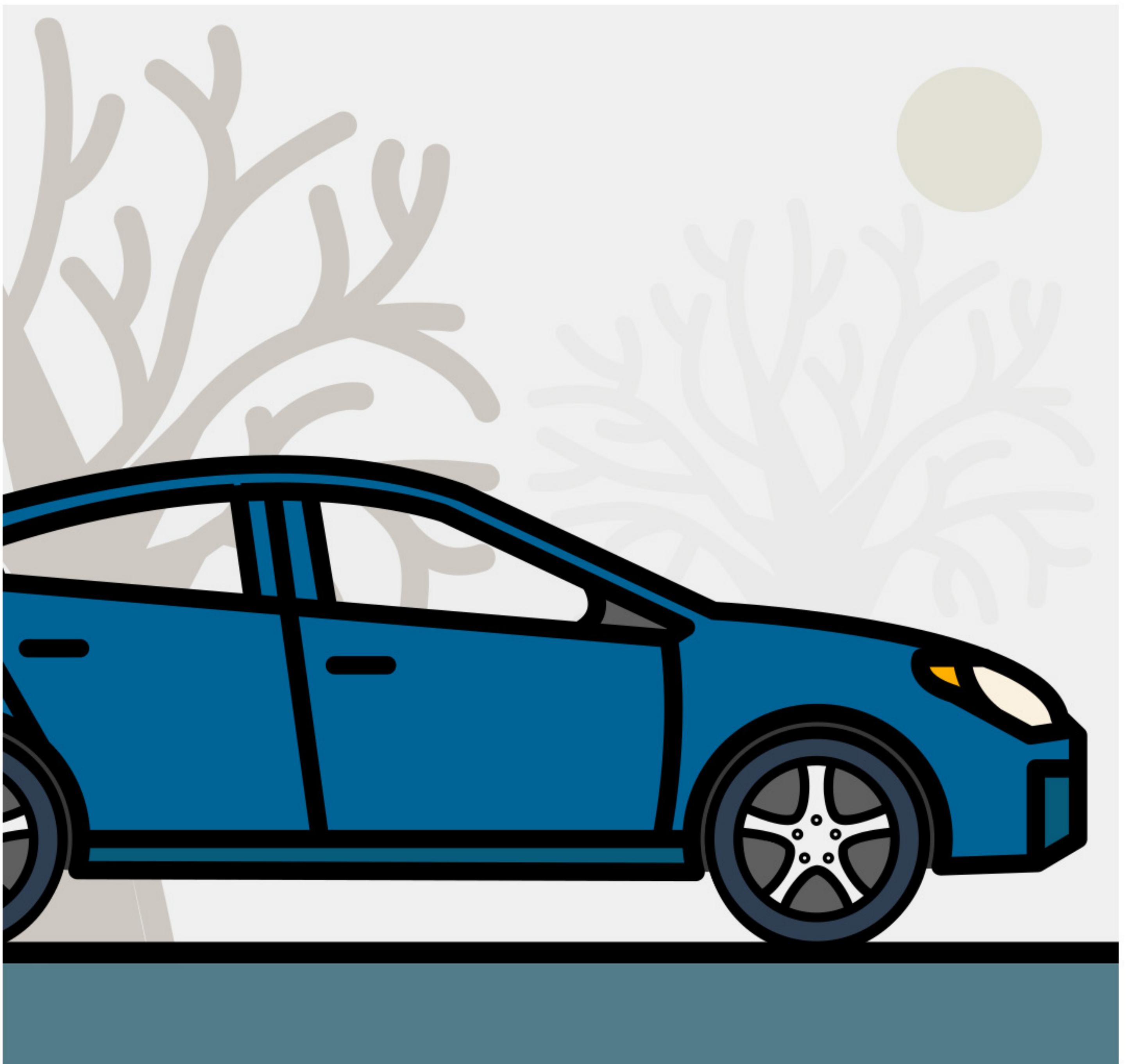
How to Change a Tire

Using a spare? Only drive short distances.

Change a Tire

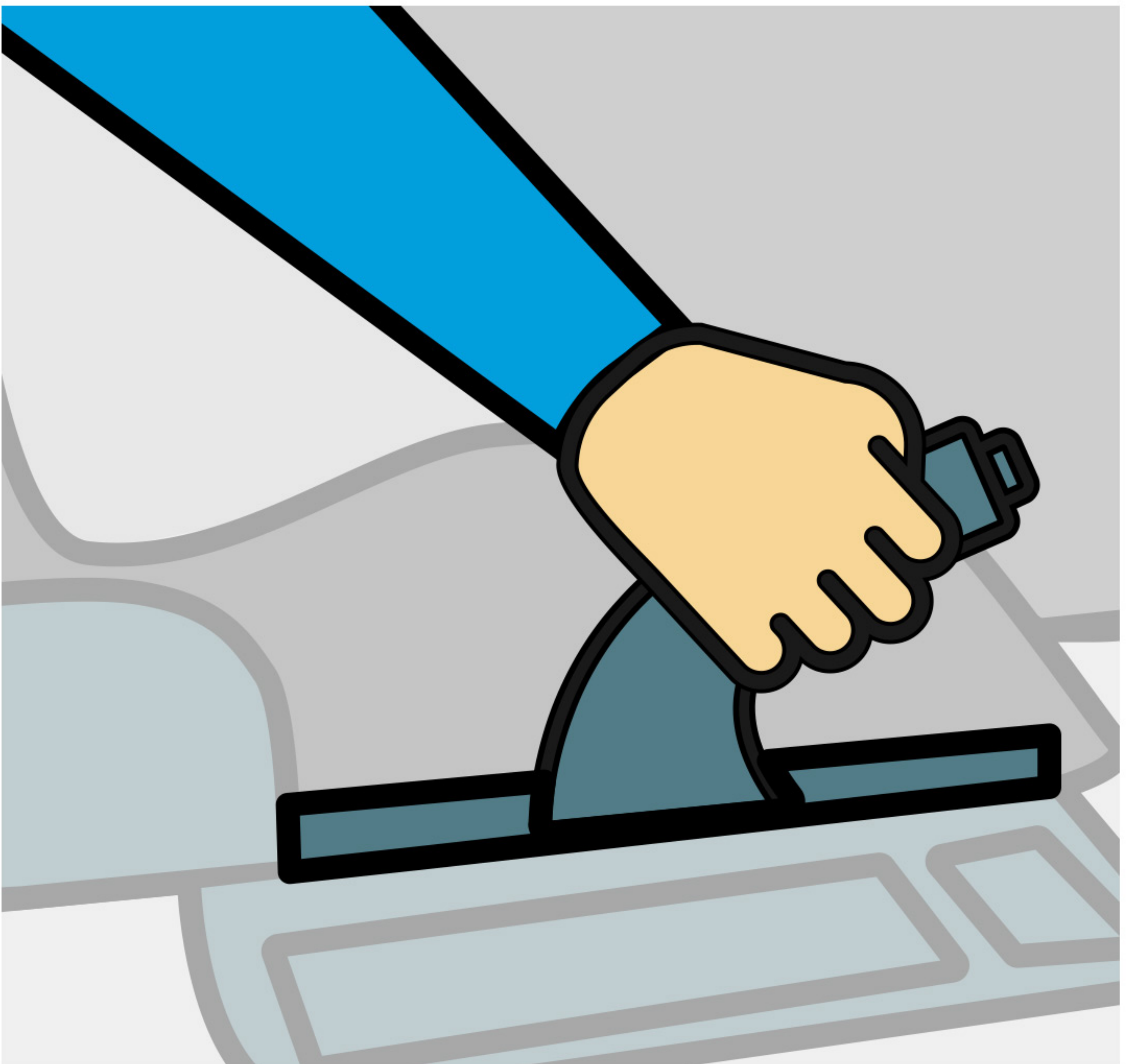
- 1 Park your car on a flat surface.



HOW TO

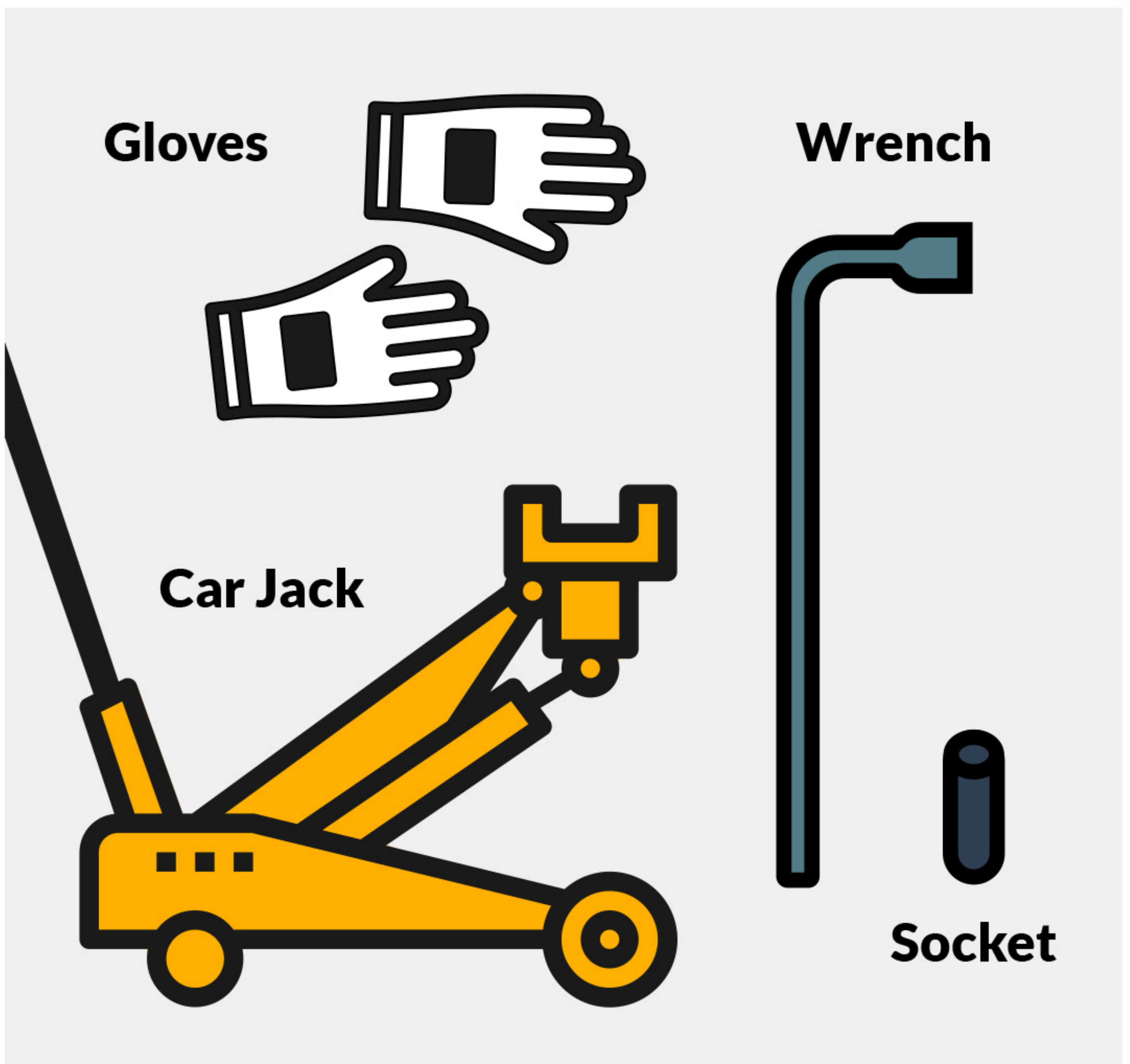
Change a Tire

- 2 Turn engine off. Engage emergency brake.



HOW TO Change a Tire

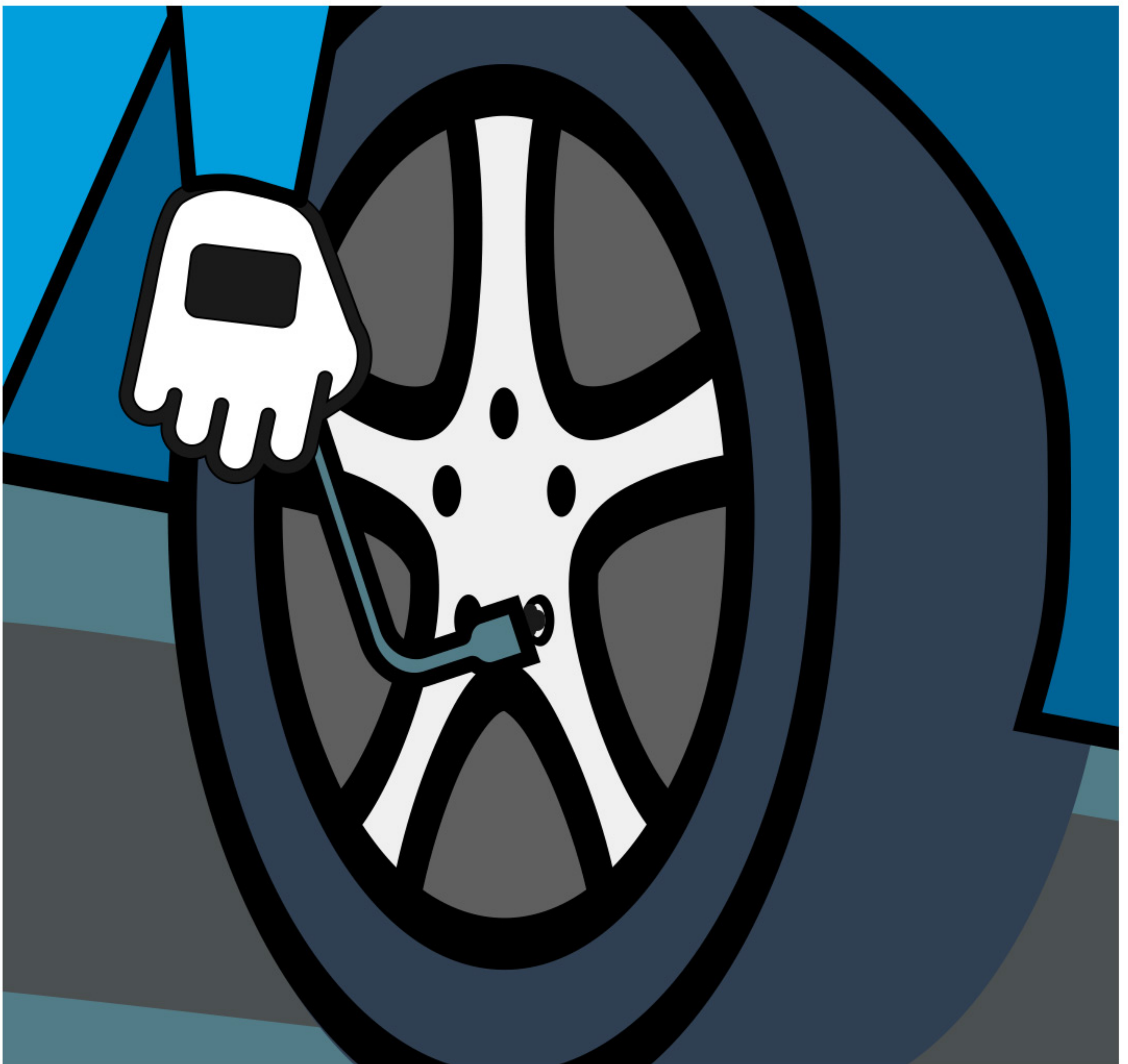
3 Gather supplies.



HOW TO

Change a Tire

- 4 With car on ground, use wrench to loosen lug nuts.



HOW TO

Change a Tire

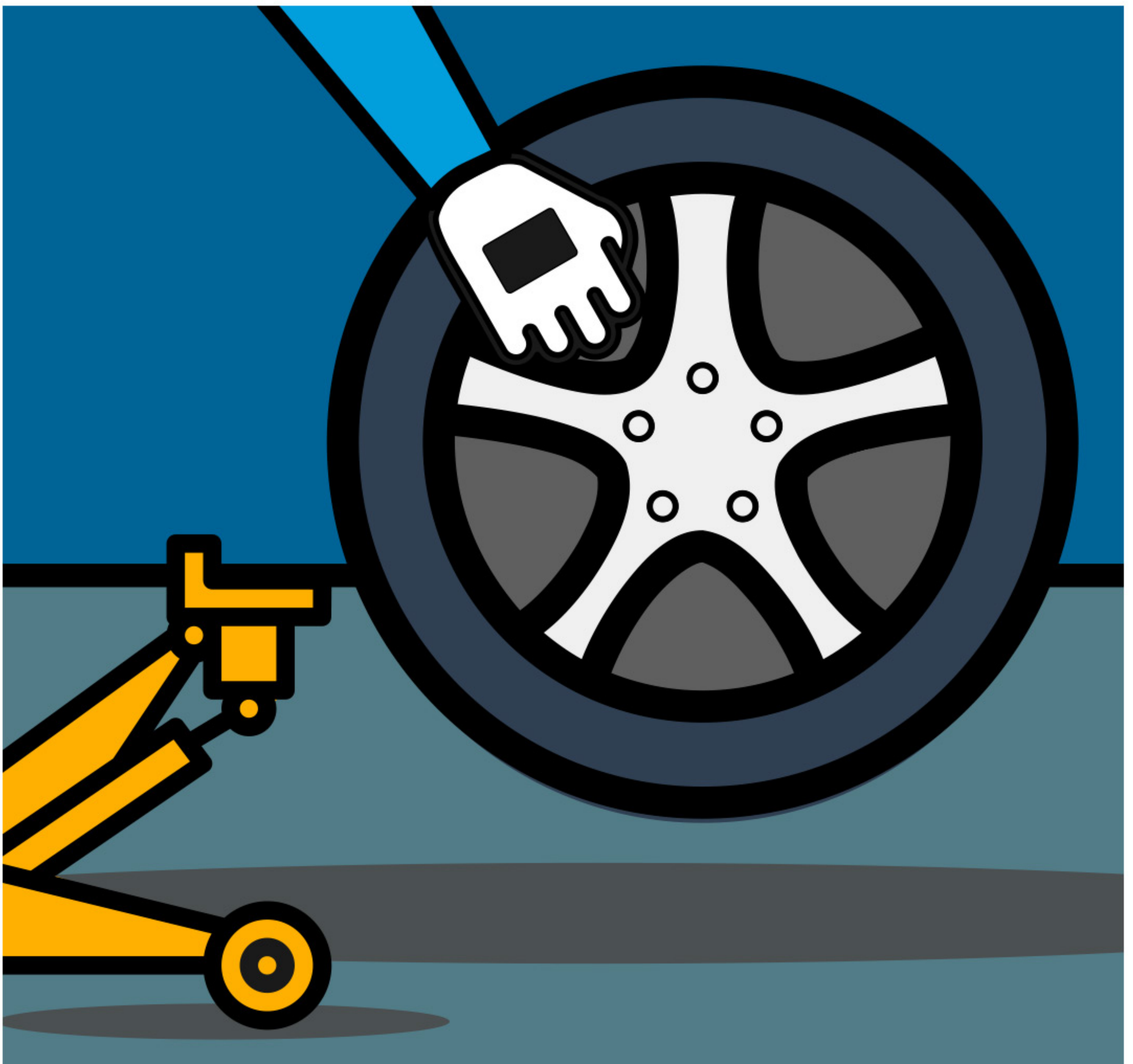
- 5 Look for a reinforced jack-point on the car. Then lift car.



HOW TO

Change a Tire

- 6 Remove lug nuts. Replace tire with spare.

Change a Tire

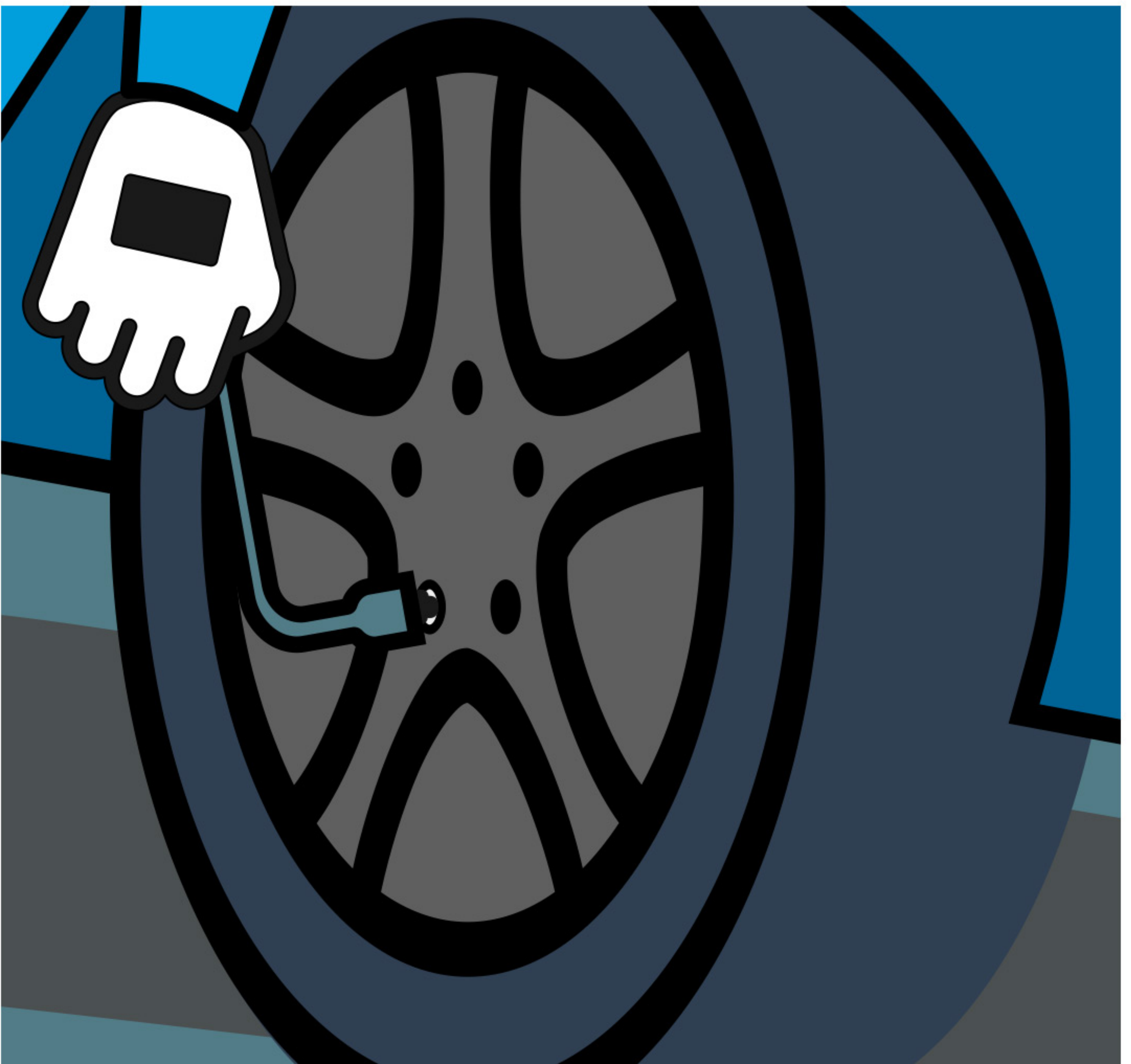
- 7 Replace lug nuts. Tighten by hand.

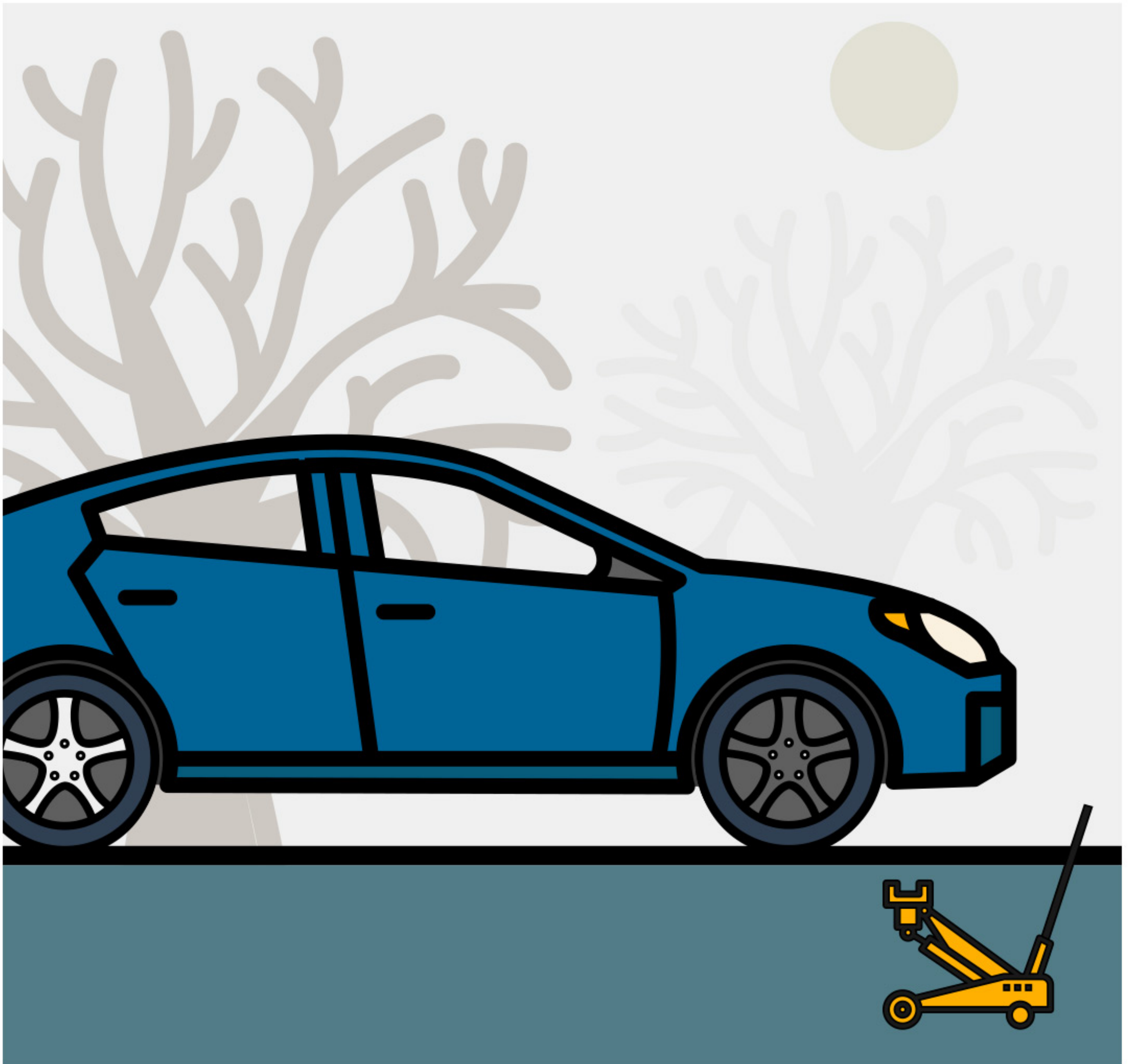
Change a Tire

- 8 Lower car. Tighten lug nuts with wrench.

- 9 Remove jack. Drive safely!



How to Jump-start Your Car

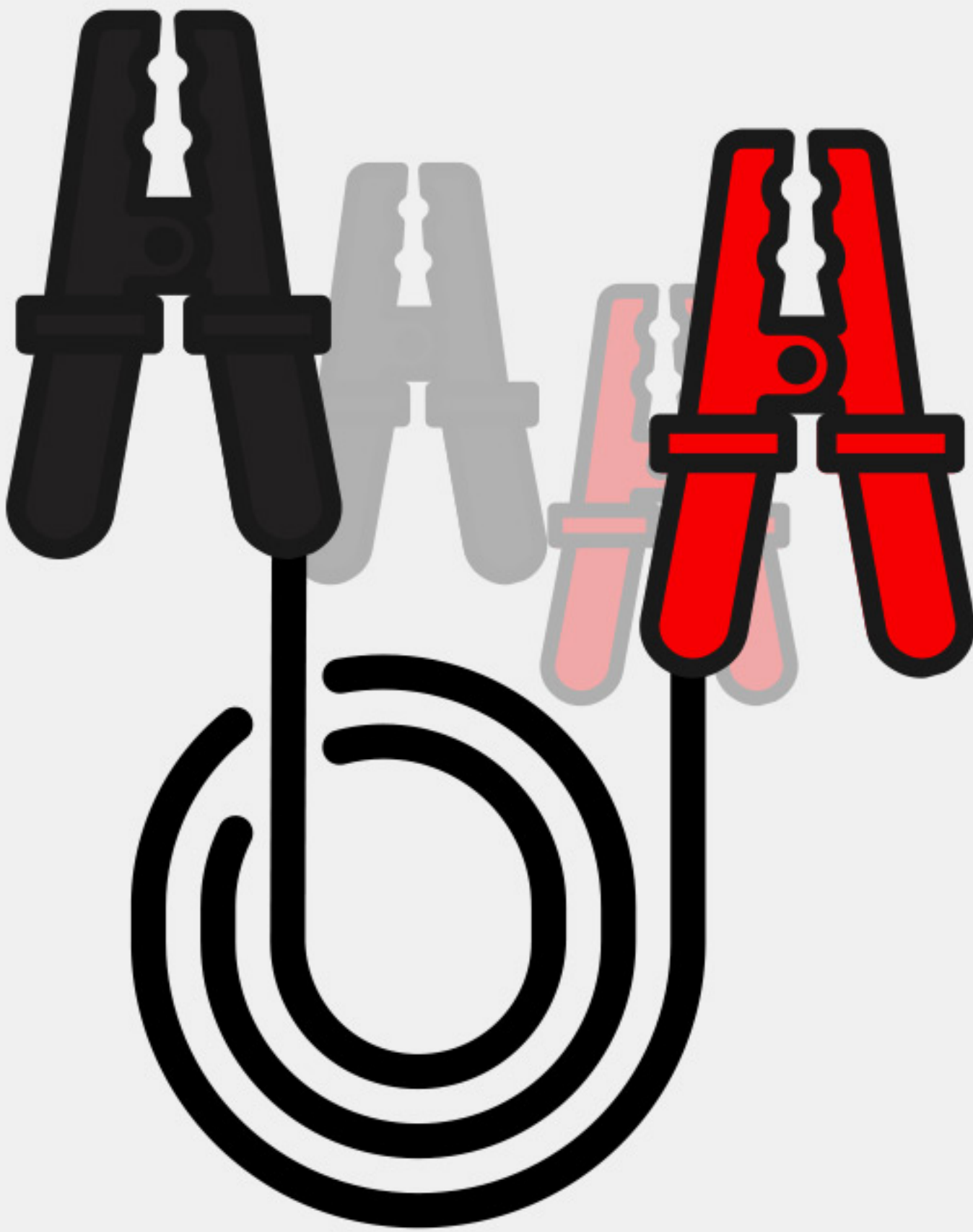
Make sure jumper

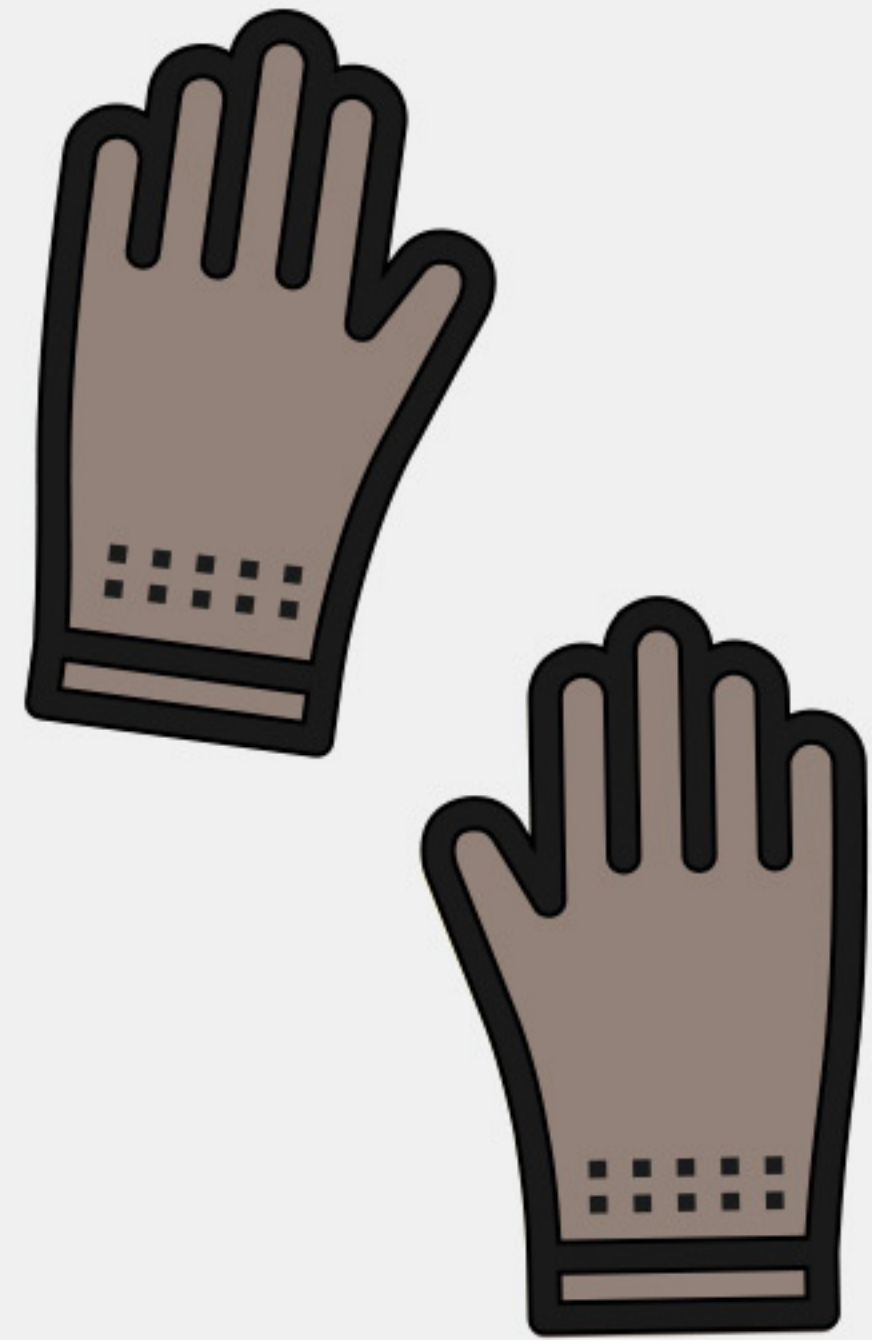

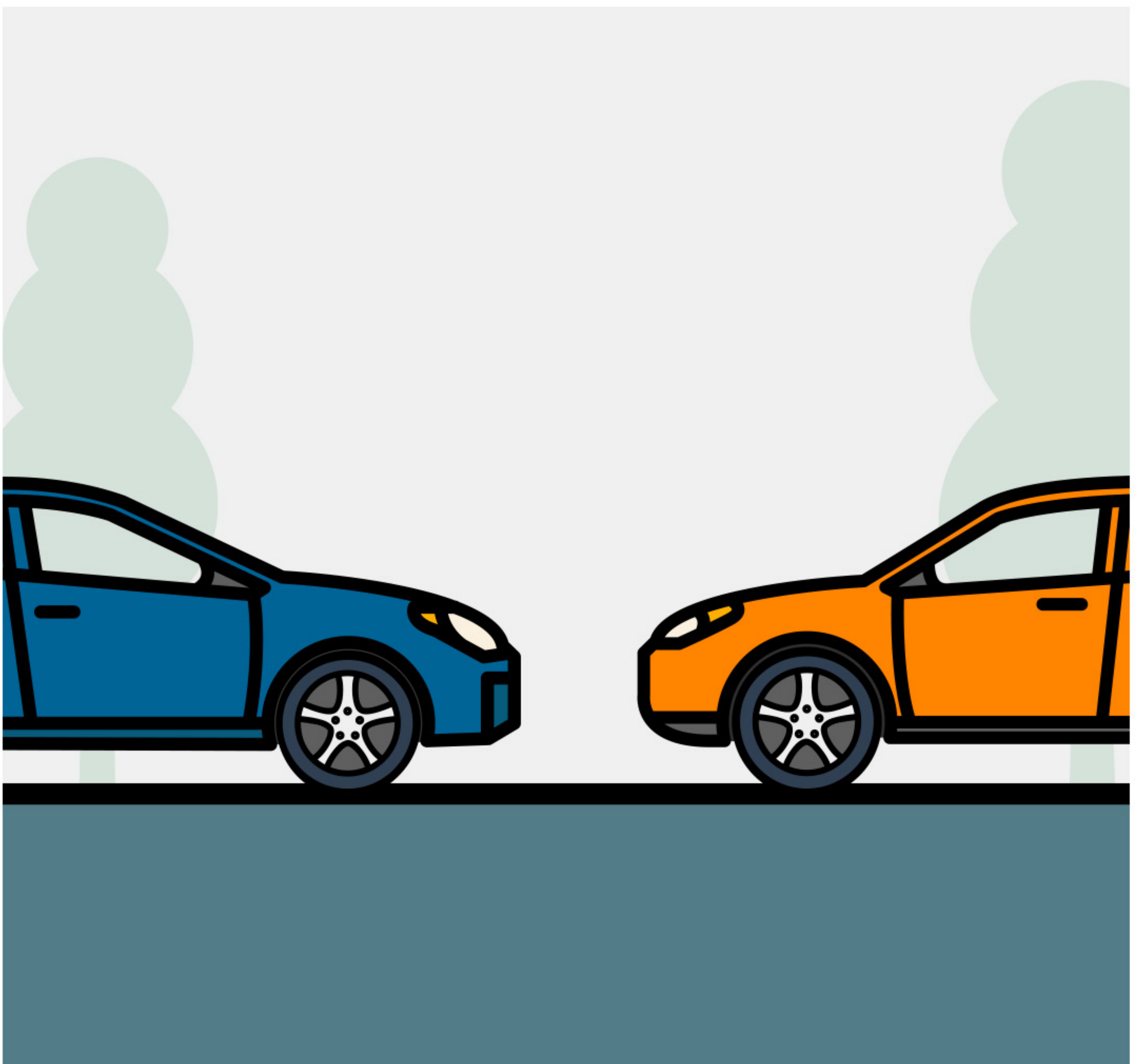
Gloves

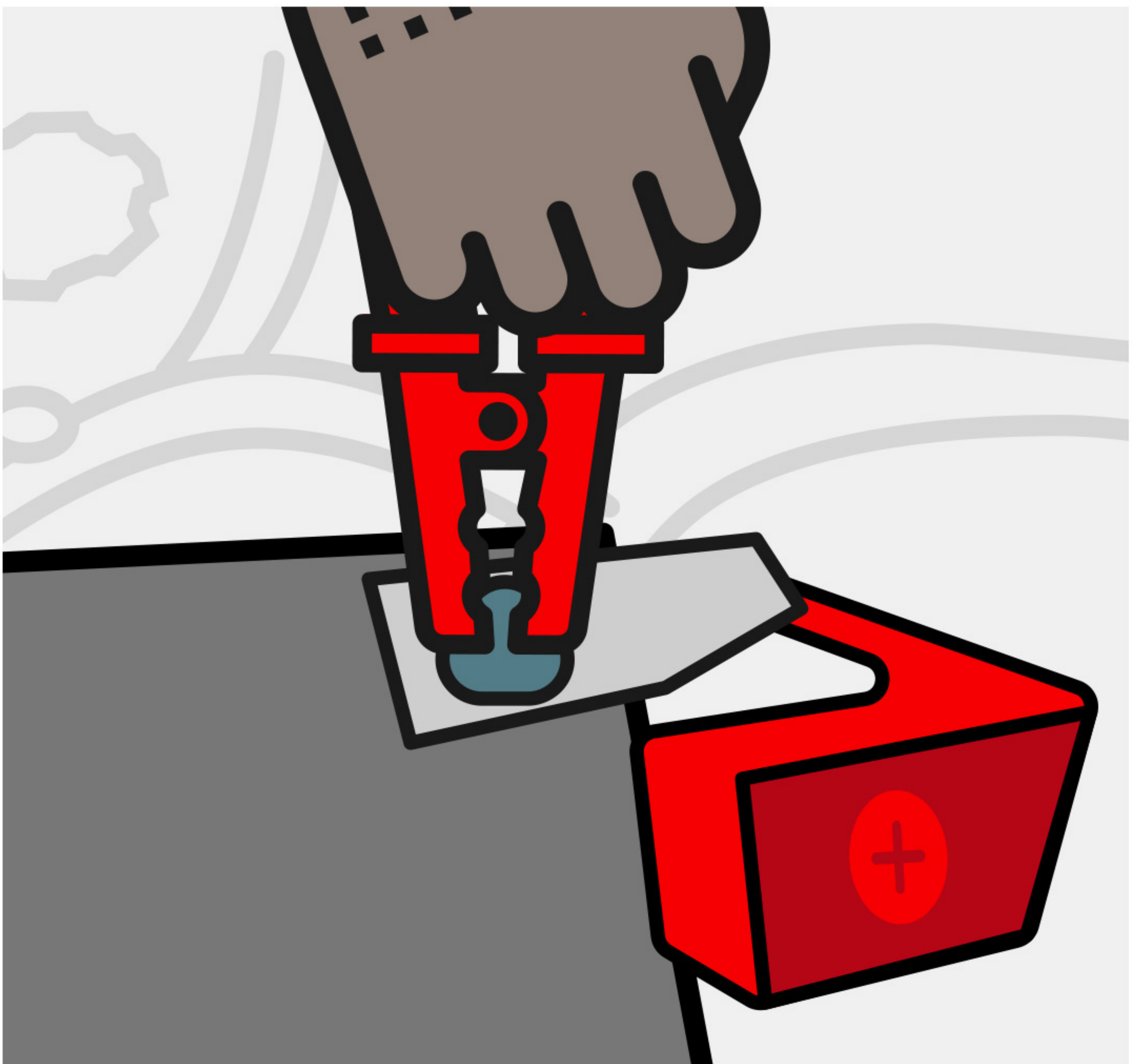
- 2 Park support car next to dead car. Turn engine off.

Jump-start Your Car

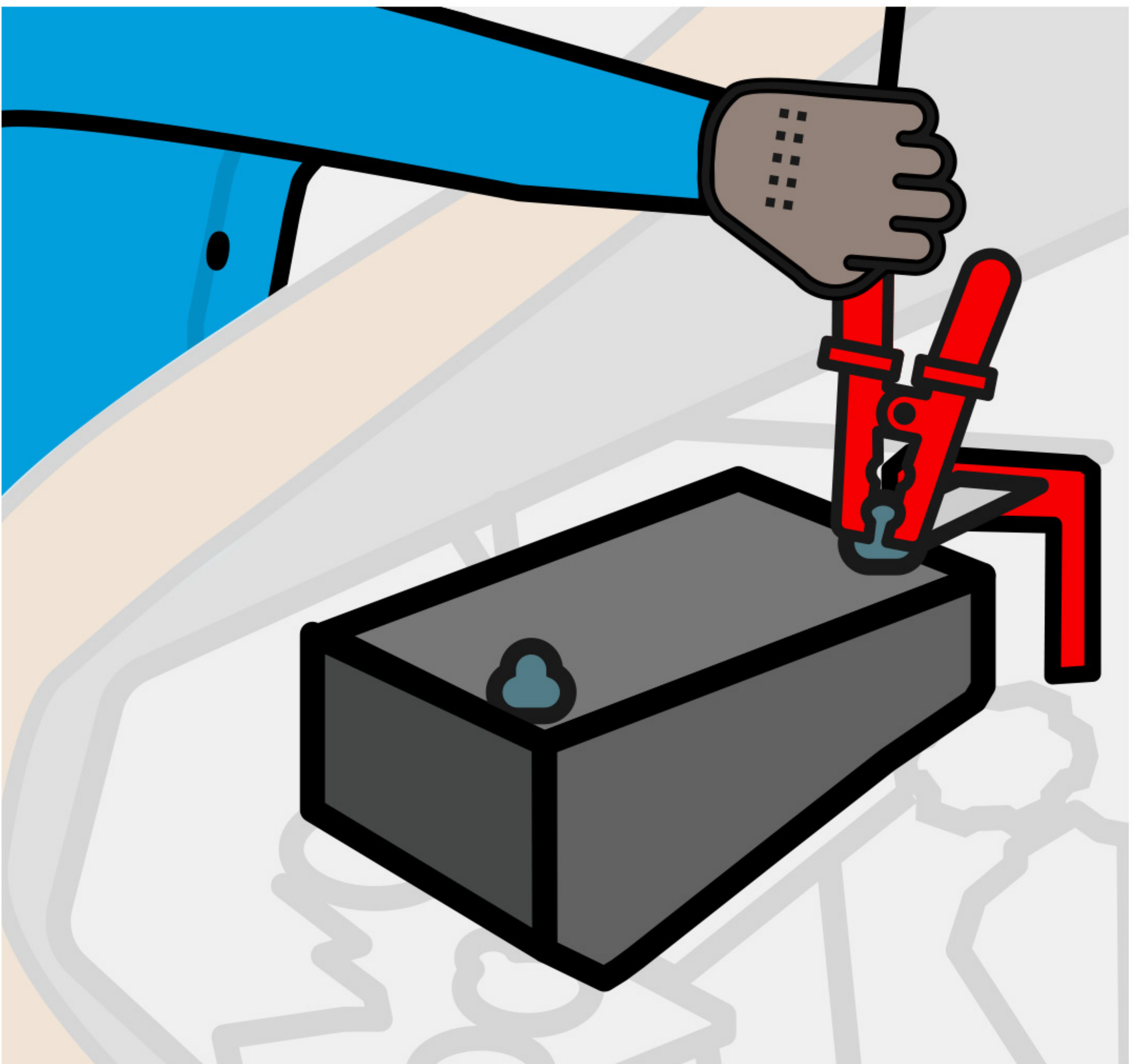
- 3 Place red clamp on positive terminal of dead car.

Jump-start Your Car

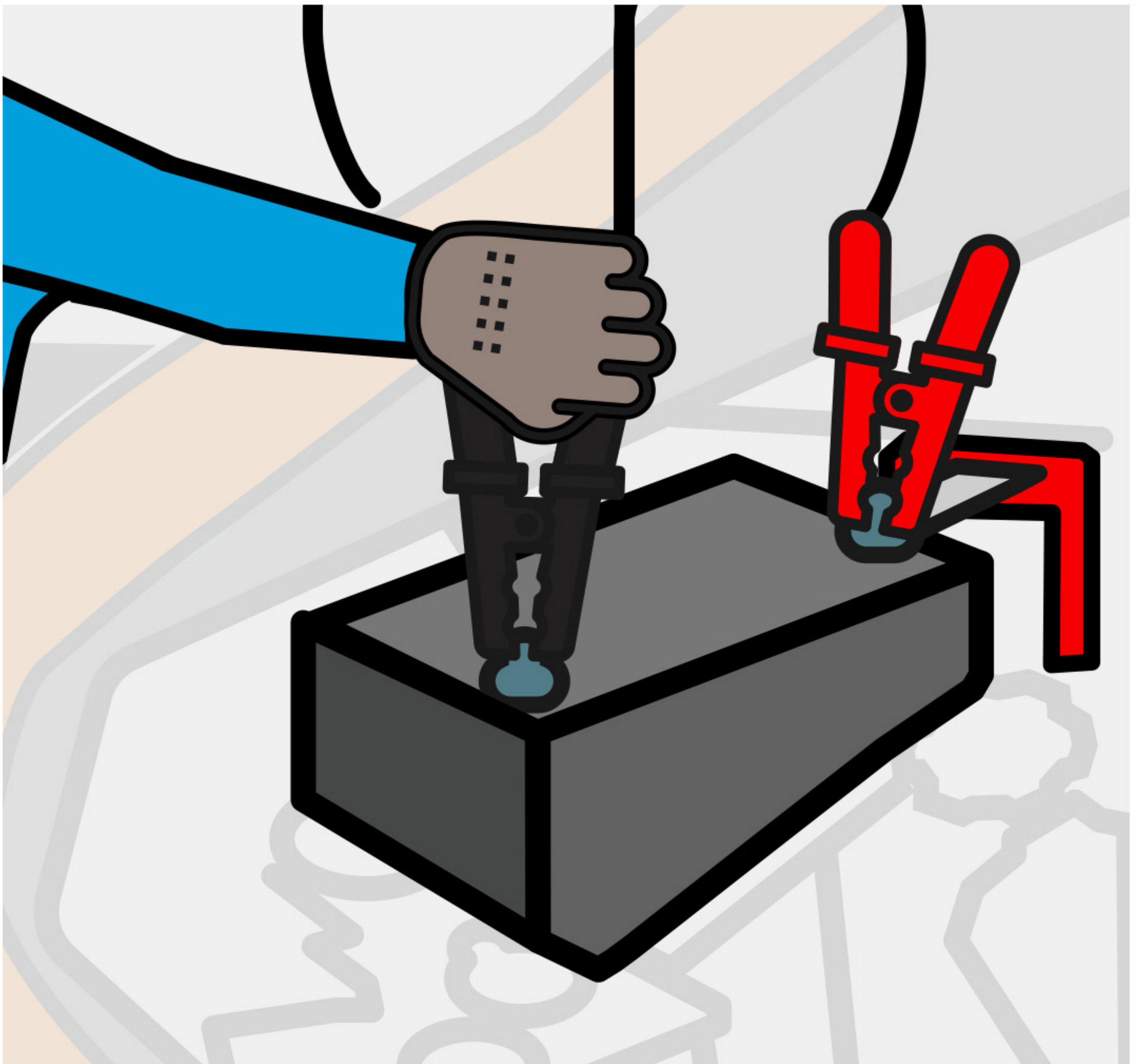
- 4 Place red clamp on positive terminal of support car.

Jump-start Your Car

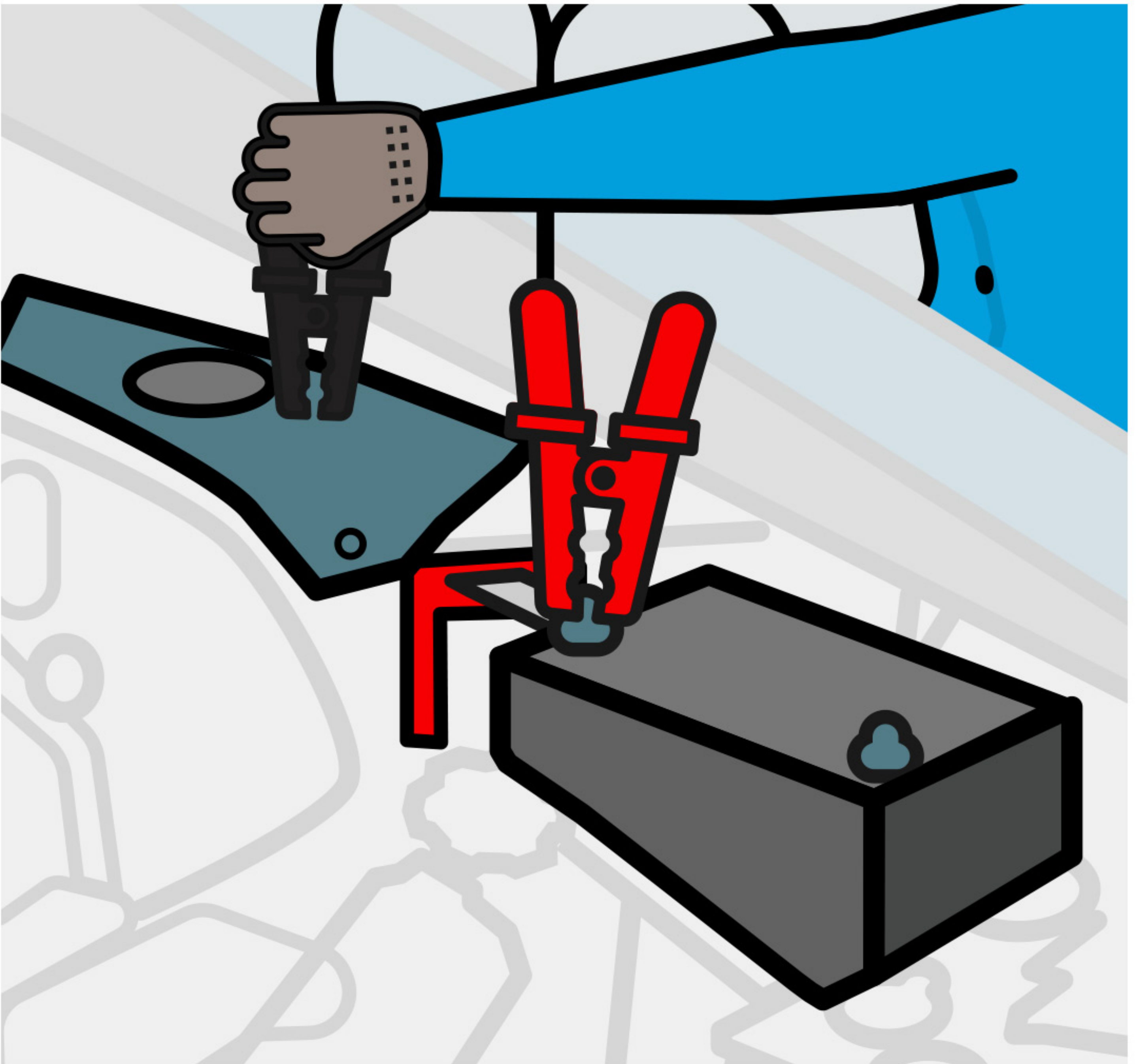
- 5 Place black clamp on negative terminal of support car.

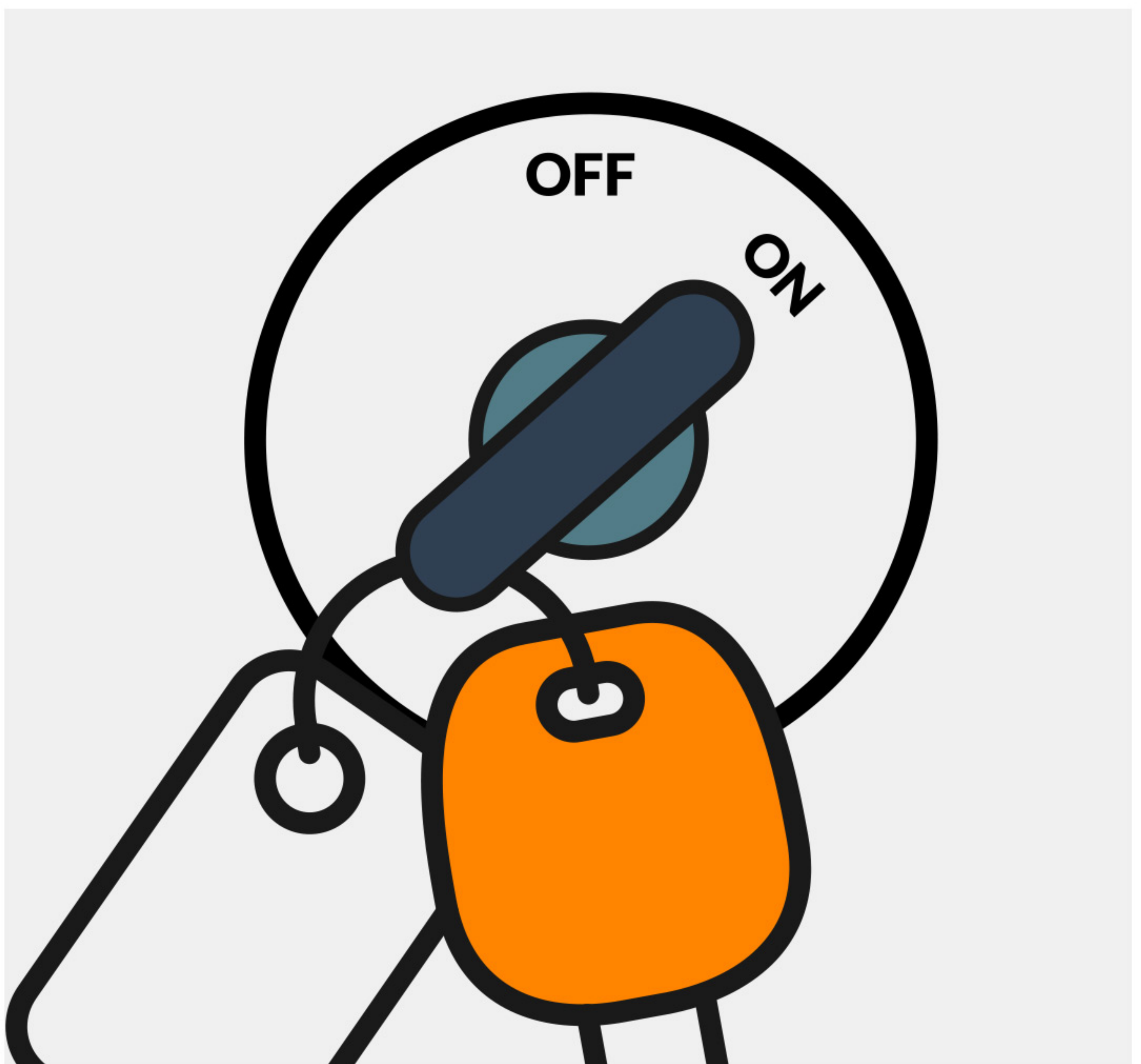
- 6 Place black clamp on piece of dead car's unpainted metal.

Jump-start Your Car

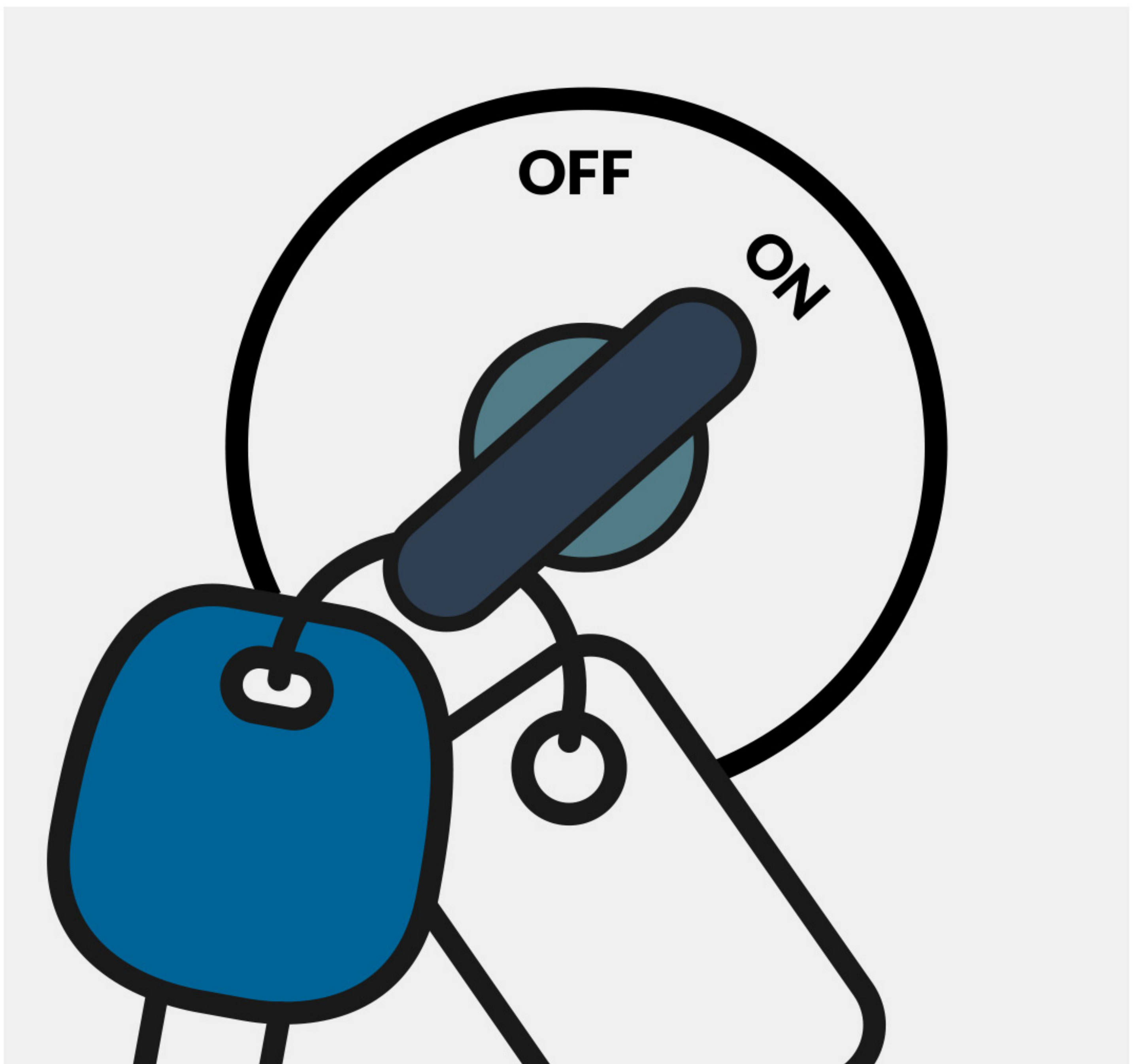
- 7 Turn on support car's engine. Let it idle.



HOW TO

Jump-start Your Car

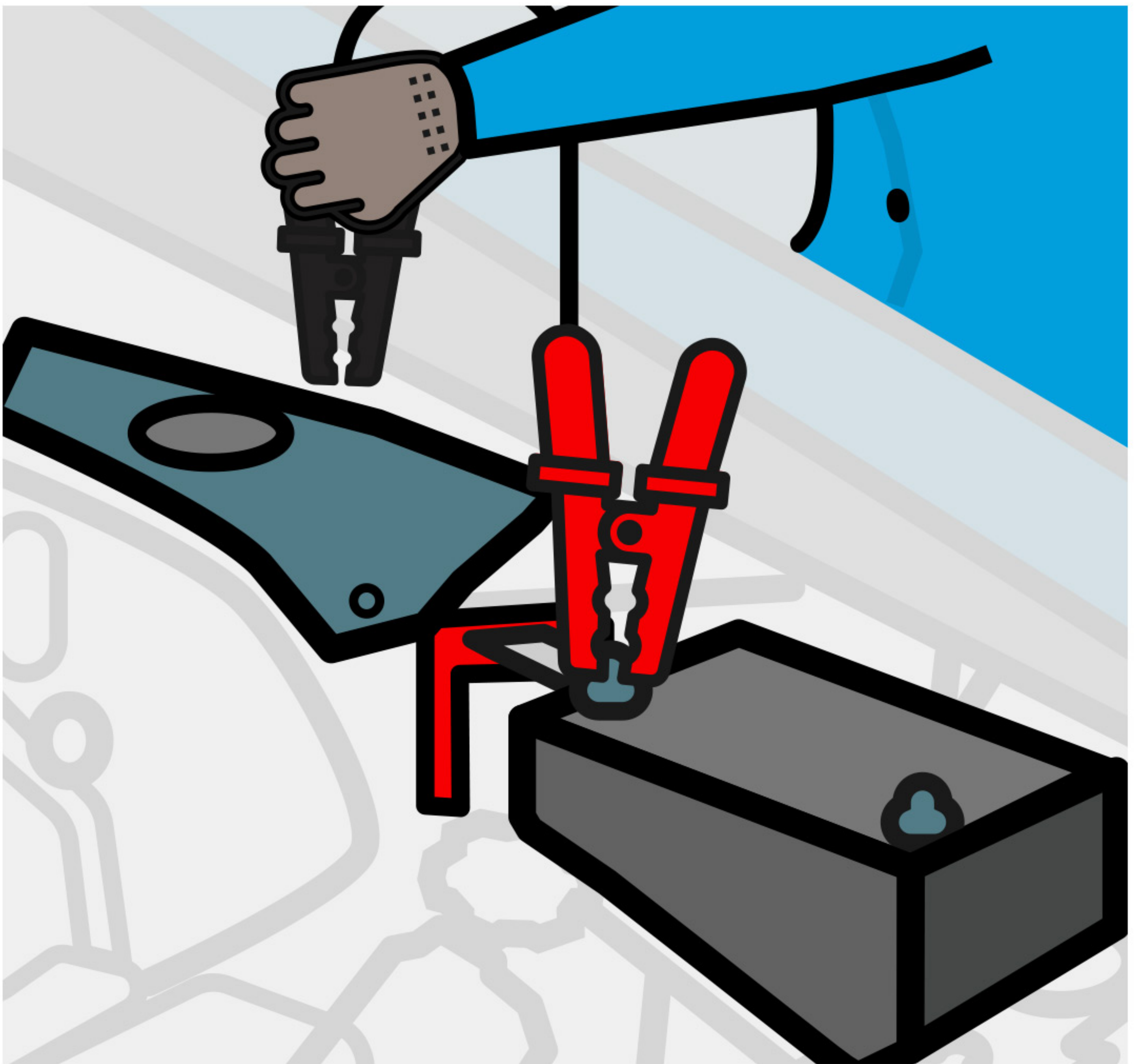
- 8 Turn on dead car's engine.
Keep it running!

- 9 Remove black clamp from piece of dead car's unpainted metal.

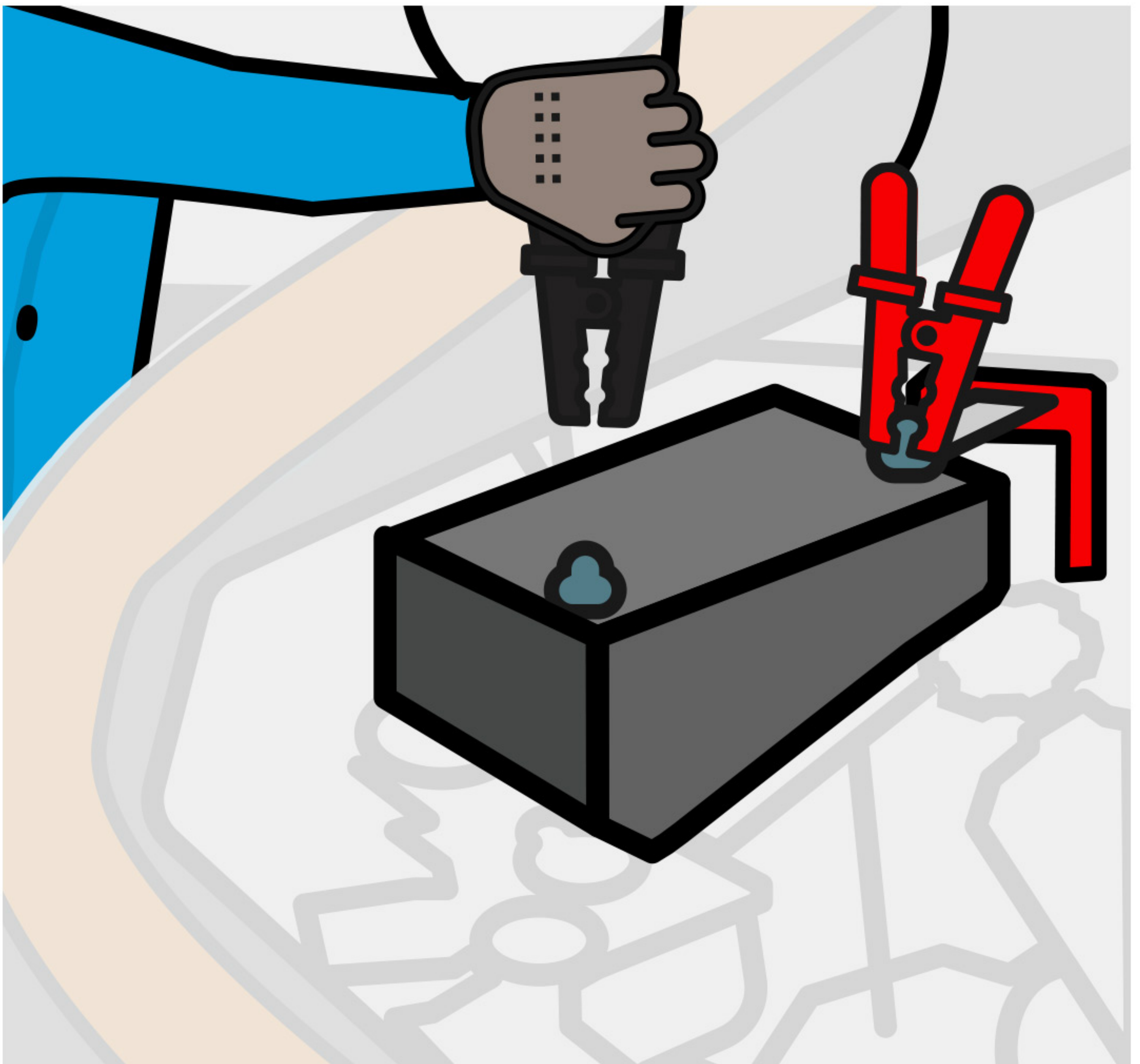

Remove black clamp from negative terminal of support car.

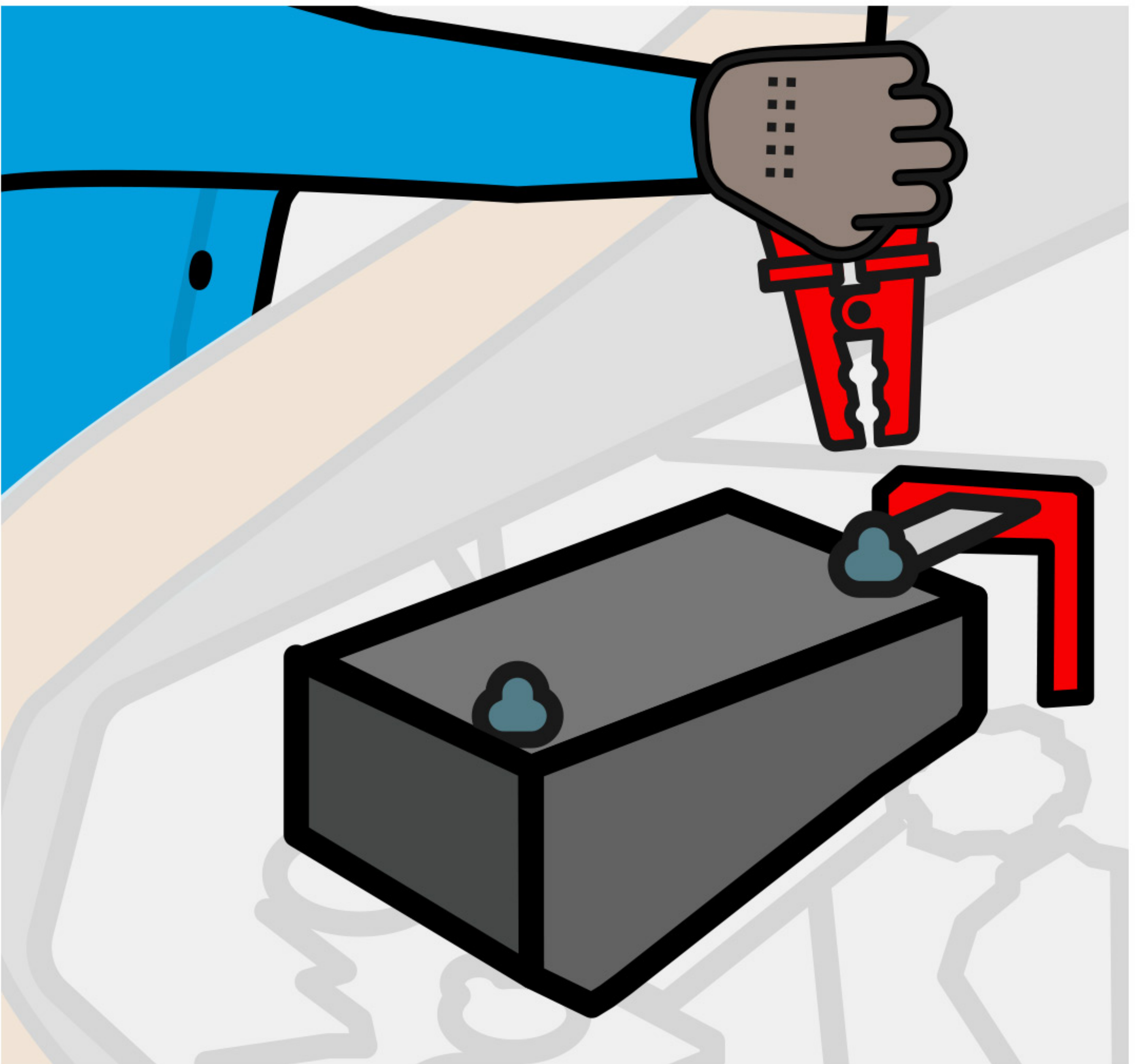

Remove red clamp from positive terminal of support car.

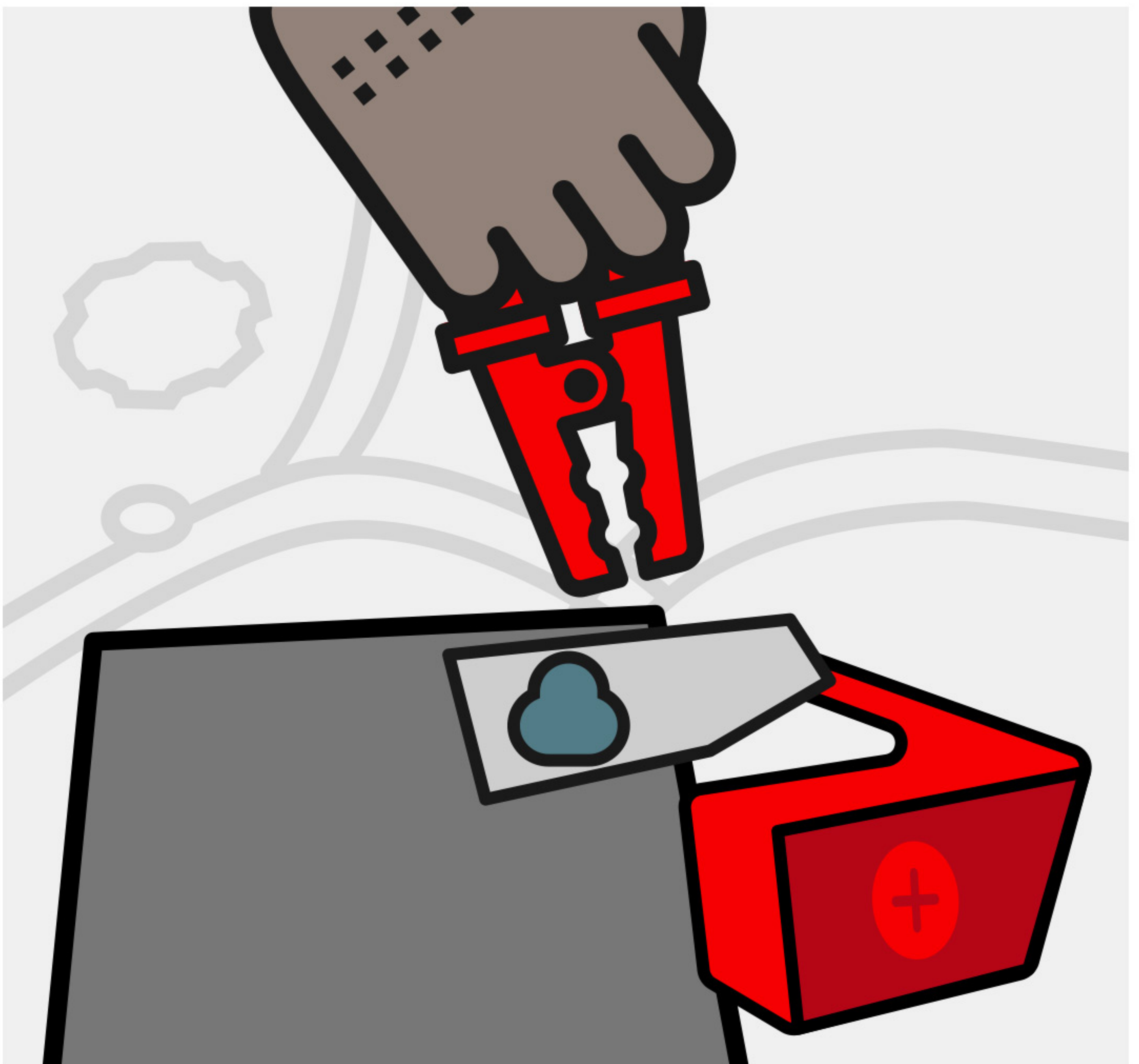

Remove red clamp from positive terminal of dead car.

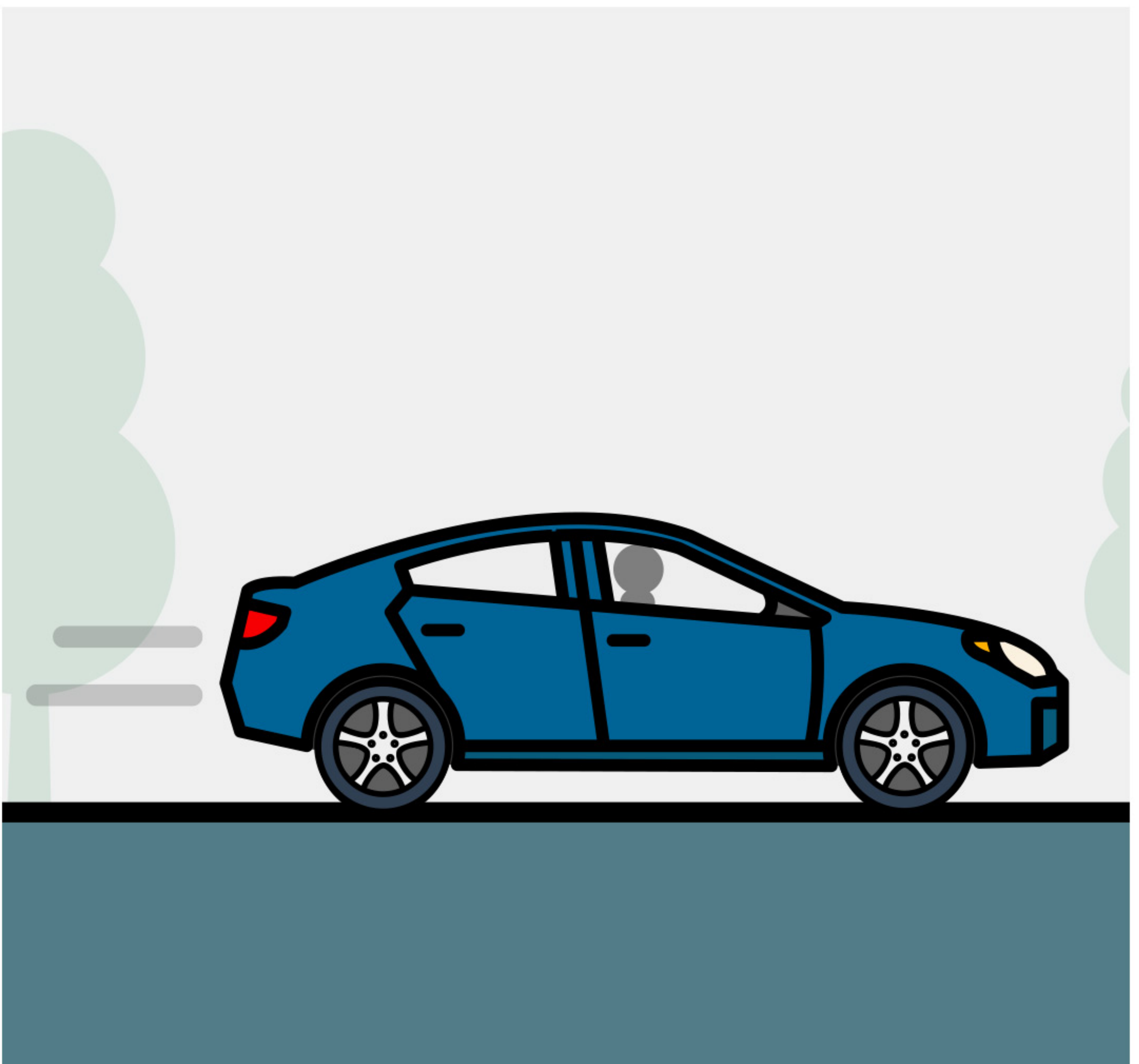
